Dave has been a member of Blue Mountains Photography group for approximately three years, and in that time we have seen the growth in his ability to continuously produce images that we have all been impressed with.

Just recently, at the Canon Australian Institute of Professional Photography awards, Dave received two GOLD and a SILVER awards and was named AIPP Australian Student Photographer of The Year. Dave was also asked to shoot images and video of PMA 2011, and complete a production that will be seen on the website as a promotion for the next show.

Dave is undertaking a Diploma of Photo Imaging at Western Sydney TAFE and is in his final year. He has already been recognised locally, state wide and internationally with numerous awards. Recently, Dave won the Winmalee Photographic award at ArtFest for one of his images. He also got two highly commended awards at TopShot 2011. His image "Gills" (the backlight mushroom) was placed in the top 20 of the International Press Association Photographic Competition Awards last year. His work is currently being shown in State Parliament house and in the local office of MP Roza Sage.
